Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

OBSERVES and FOLLOWS safety rules and regulations including wearing safety apparel and devices during the course and scope of job related duties.

TREATS sick or injured patients as a PFD first responder for Cypress Creek EMS.

PERFORMS all duties related to fire rescue, including connecting and carrying fire hoses, carrying and setting up ladders, directing water and chemicals on burning structures, vegetation, vehicles and other objects.

VENTILATES buildings and conducts salvage operations. MUST maintain physical fitness to perform all duties.

RESCUES persons trapped in vehicles, burning buildings and other places.

DEVELOPS and PRESENTS fire service related education and training programs as defined by the PFD.

OPERATES and DRIVES emergency vehicles and equipment and may be required to ride in charge of fire apparatus in the absence of an officer or at other times as necessary and required by the Fire Chief or his designee.
