WHO NEEDS TO REGISTER?

Any temporary or organized event with:

- 100+ attendees outdoors (parking lots, roadsides, open land, etc.)
- 50+ attendees indoors in buildings not designed for assembly use

Register **at least 30 days in advance** when possible. Early registration helps **avoid delays or event shutdowns.**

FOOD AND PUBLIC HEALTH



- Food vendors, temporary booths or mobile food units (MFU's)
- Certified Food Manager & Food Handler Certificates
